17.1, Purpose

The Town Board of West Lakeland finds that the manner of keeping of dogs, cats and other animals may be in conflict with the public health, safety and welfare, including stormwater contamination and may constitute a public nuisance or otherwise be detrimental to the general welfare.

17.2.6 (addition to)

DOMESTIC ANIMALS are limited to cats and dogs.

17.10 Pet Waste Management:

The owner or keeper of any domestic animal (cats and dogs) shall be responsible for the immediate removal and proper disposal of any feces deposited by such domestic animal on any property, public or private, not owned or exclusively occupied by the owner or keeper. The owner or keeper of any animal shall also be responsible for the periodic removal and proper disposal of feces deposited on property owned or exclusively occupied by such owner or keeper such as to prevent the creation of a public nuisance.
