Chairman's Corner

Where's the Snow? Fortunately, we have been experiencing a mild winter as compared to the previous two or three winters. If this winter continues to be mild, the trucks will not be needed as often, and we will likely stay under the 2016 snow plow budget of \$100,000. This will free up money for some overdue road maintenance projects.



The Levy. As predictable as anything else, with the economy slowly improving, the cost of doing township business increases right along with it. Maintenance and repairs to our roads and stormwater systems continue to drive up costs. Last year, the Board managed to offset some of these rising costs by contracting with Tennis Sanitation. They provide services for our recycling and Annual Clean-Up Day for less cost than in previous years. This year, the Board will be proposing a levy increase of 1.6% at the Township Annual Meeting on March 8, 2016. Unfortunately, we couldn't squeeze anymore juice from a dry turnip!

What's happening with Lake Elmo Airport? After a number of public involvement meetings within the past few months, MAC (Metropolitan Airports Commission) staffers proposed a revised plan of the runway expansion project to the residents and the Board. MAC proposed shortening the NW to SE runway by 100 ft (3600' to 3500') and to reroute 30th Street around the South end of the runway, back up to the Neal Avenue and eastbound 30th Street intersection. The Board, along with nearby residents, did not feel this was much of a compromise. So another public involvement meeting is scheduled for February 11, at the Baytown Community Center, and an additional public comment period has been established.
