Chairman's Corner

Hwy 95 is getting a New Facelift

MNDOT will be repaving the section of Hwy 95 this summer from the City of Bayport, south to I-94. Expect frequent delays and re-routing of traffic. If possible, it will be best to avoid this section of Hwy 95. More information regarding MNDOT's Hwy 95 project is on our Township website.



3M Settlement and PFAS

The Township continues to work with the MPCA and MDH to monitor the movement of PFAS, the 3M chemical that leaked into the groundwater and has contaminated many of the wells in the southern half of our township. Wood, an environmental consultant hired by the MPCA, will soon be presenting a ground water model to the 3M Workgroup, a group comprised of municipalities affected by the PFAS contamination, to help us further understand the movement of PFAS. This information will help the municipalities decide what alternatives are feasibly available to treat this contamination in each of their individual communities.

Expect a Small Bump in the Levy for 2021

The Town Board sat down a couple of weeks ago and hammered out a budget for 2021. The Town Board was able to keep most costs at bay, but you should expect about a 5% increase in the levy. Much of the increase is due to normal inflationary costs to do business (i.e., road and ditch maintenance) as well as the addition of about a mile of new road, built for a new subdivision, which the township will now have to snowplow and maintain. The Town Board will present the 2021 budget and levy at the Annual Township Meeting on March 10th for approval.

Lake Elmo Airport Expansion and 30th St Realignment Update

Construction of the realignment of 30th St between Neal Ave and Manning Ave continues to move forward. Winter work of removing and replacing poor soils in the subbase will end shortly and allow the subbase to settle until this summer. Work on the road will then resume and continue into the fall. The township is working diligently with MAC to ensure that the new realigned road is appropriately constructed, and that the haul route, or western half mile of 30th St before Manning, will be properly repaired after the project is completed.
