

Special Meeting Minutes

11 am, February 27th, 2020

Cottage Grove City Hall, Cottage Grove, MN

Attendance: Wood Consultants: Hannah Albertus-Benham, Erin Daugherty, Brian Hamrick, James Feild, MPCA Representatives: Gary Krueger, Andri Dahlmeier, Supervisors Dave Schultz and Marian Appelt, Chairman Daniel Kylo, Township Engineer Ryan Stempski.

Purpose: Wood Consultants and MPCA Representatives were meeting with the affected municipalities listed in the 3M PFAS Settlement at the Cottage Grove City Hall to review and answer questions regarding the 3M Settlement Conceptual Drinking Water Supply Plan (CDWP) and Ground Water Model.

Wood Consultants opened the presentation displaying a map of the east metro area. It illustrated where PFAS was sampled and how the ground water flow patterns carried PFAS throughout the east metro and West Lakeland. Several possible PFAS treatment and water supply scenarios and their costs were presented by Wood and the MPCA in the CDWP for consideration. These treatment scenarios ranged from the installation of GAC filters in all of the affect households to a municipal water supply system. Engineer Stempski asked several technical questions related to the scenarios, such as, logistics and materials used.

One of the several West Lakeland scenarios involved a joint integrated water supply plan with the Prairie Island Indian Community (PIIC) and their property within West Lakeland. Wood/MPCA suggested that West Lakeland may want to contact PIIC to inquire their level of interest in a possible joint integrated water supply project. Chairman Kylo volunteered to contact PIIC and gauge their level of interest.

Wood and the MPCA also announced that the comment period deadline for the CDWP was extended to Friday, March 6th and that West Lakeland should submit their comments before then. Chairman Kylo suggested that Mr. Stempski draft West Lakeland's comments and the Board hold a special meeting before March 6th to review his draft comments before submission. Chairman Kylo will contact Town Clerk Seifert and schedule a special meeting before March 6th.

The Presentation and Q&A session ended at 1:30pm.
