



Special Meeting – Review Attorney Proposals and Roads Discussion

Chairman Moosbrugger called the meeting to order at 7:09 p.m.

The supervisors drafted a list of questions in preparation for the attorney interviews:

Availability to attend all the regular township board meetings?

Will one person be designated to the township meetings for continuity?

General monthly costs in their experience with providing legal services to townships?

Experience with townships incorporating into a city, imminent domain, recodification and ability to flyspeck?

Philosophy with interjecting at board meetings to protect the board/township?

Available back up attorney during scheduling conflicts?

Litigation experience?

Fees charged to a resident vs township with regards to escrow fees?

May 7, 8, 10, 15, 20, and 21 have been reserved for attorney interviews. Clerk Seifert will contact attorneys to set up interviews.

Supervisor Buelow stated that 8 miles of crack sealing will cost roughly \$4,000. Gopher State is the current contractor. Based on feedback from Chad Isakson, Buelow recommended crack-sealing the new roads first, then work our way down from there.

Supervisor Dana motioned to adjourn the meeting at 8:35 pm, seconded by Supervisor Buelow, motion carried.
